### **Clinical Counsellor Permanent Part Time Position 14 Hours Per Week**

This position requires a highly motivated and self-directed professional who is able to provide evidence-based counselling services to individuals in the Niagara Region who are involved with the criminal justice system.

- Provide general assessment and trauma-informed individual counselling to men and women
- Collaborate with Probation Officers, the Domestic Violence Court, and other community partners
- Outreach and collaborate with community partners
- Maintain reports and statistical information as required
- Maintain up to date documentation
- Maintain standards of ethical professional practice and engage in clinical supervision
